1985 Wisconsin Act 175

AN ACT to create 66.906 (4) of the statutes, relating to eligibility of employes of a sewerage commission of a 1st class city for certain benefits.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 66.906 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

66.906 (4) RETIREMENT BENEFITS. Any employe of the district hired on or after April 26, 1982, is eligible

to participate in any compensation or benefit program in which employes of a sewerage commission of a 1st class city under ss. 62.60 to 62.27, 1979 stats., participated, and such program shall treat the employe as eligible to participate in such program. If an employe of the district is receiving retirement benefits from

such a program at the time of employment by the district, such employe is not eligible to participate in the program unless the employe elects to suspend his or

her retirement benefit payments during his or her employment by the district.
