1985 Wisconsin Act 249

AN ACT relating to adjustments in jurisdictional mileage responsibilities and the functional classification of highways used in transportation aid calculations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions; transportation. (1) JURISDICTIONAL MILEAGE ADJUSTMENT. Notwithstanding section 86.305 of the statutes, a change in jurisdictional mileage responsibility or the functional classification of a highway certified by the department of transportation by May 1, 1985, which would reduce a municipality's transportation aid for calendar year 1986 shall not be reflected in the transportation aid calculations for 1986 if the municipality challenges the certification prior to December 31,

1985, and the department of transportation agrees that a revision in jurisdictional mileage responsibility or the functional classification of a highway should be made at the next certification. The department of transportation shall use the revised functional classification or jurisdictional mileage responsibility in the transportation aid calculations for calendar year 1986.

(2) Notwithstanding section 86.30 (4) (e) 1 of the statutes, the department shall make any adjustment in the payment of transportation aids required under this SECTION in calendar year 1986.
