1985 Wisconsin Act 251

AN ACT to create 121.105 (3) of the statutes, relating to providing special adjustment aids to consolidated school districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 121.105 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

121.105 (3) In the school year in which a school district consolidation takes effect under s. 117.06 and in each of the subsequent 2 school years, the consolidated school district's state aid shall be an amount

that is not less than the aggregate state aid received by the consolidating school districts in the school year prior to the school year in which the consolidation takes effect. The additional state aid shall be paid from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (ac).

SECTION 2. Initial applicability. This act first applies to consolidations of school districts under section 117.06 of the statutes occurring on July 1, 1986.
