1985 Wisconsin Act 51

AN ACT to create 36.27 (2) (cm) of the statutes, relating to creating an exemption from nonresident tuition at the university of Wisconsin system.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 36.27 (2) (cm) of the statutes is created to read:

36.27 (2) (cm) Any student employed full time by a business in this state who was relocated to this state for business purposes by his or her current employer or who has accepted employment with a business

located in this state before moving to this state, and the spouse of any such student, is entitled to the exemption under par. (a), if that student intends to establish and maintain a permanent home in Wisconsin, as determined by the criteria set forth in par. (e).

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect May 1, 1986.
