1985 Wisconsin Act 98

AN ACT to amend 343.50 (2) and 343.50 (9) of the statutes, relating to identification cards issued by the department of transportation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 343.50 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.50 (2) Who may apply. Any resident of this state who is at least 16 years of age and who does not possess a valid operator's license issued under this chapter may apply to the department for an identification card pursuant to this section. The card is not a license for purposes of this chapter and is to be used for identification purposes only. In this subsection, a license does not include an instruction permit issued under this chapter.

SECTION 2. 343.50 (9) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.50 (9) SURRENDER OF CARDS OR OTHER LICENSES. If a person who has an identification card issued under this section subsequently obtains an operator's license under this chapter, the person shall surrender the identification card to the department when applying for the operator's license. If a person who applies for an identification card under this section has an operator's license issued by another jurisdiction, the person shall surrender that license to the department when applying for an identification card under this section. In this subsection, a license does not include an instruction permit issued under this chapter.
