1987 Wisconsin Act 103

AN ACT to create 125.51 (4) (p) of the statutes, relating to issuance of a license to sell intoxicating liquor by a town to a tavern under certain circumstances.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 125.51 (4) (p) of the statutes is created to read:

125.51 (4) (p) Notwithstanding its quota, a town which borders on a lake, is adjacent to a 2nd class city

and is located in a county with a population of 300,000 or more may issue a license for a tavern which is covered by a Class "B" license on the effective date of this paragraph [revisor inserts date], if the tavern is not located within 500 feet of a lake.
