1987 Wisconsin Act 120

AN ACT to create 186.35 (3) (n) of the statutes, relating to allowing the Wisconsin credit union savings insurance corporation to pay dividends to its members.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 186.35 (3) (n) of the statutes is created to read:

186.35 (3) (n) As determined by the trustees, declare and pay dividends in cash or property to its

members, except that the corporation may not declare or pay a dividend unless the commissioner has approved the dividend.
