## 1987 Wisconsin Act 162

AN ACT to amend 59.07 (3) (a) of the statutes, relating to delegation of county board powers relating to accounts and claims.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 59.07 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.07 (3) (a) Examine and settle all accounts of the county and all claims, demands or causes of action against the county and issue county orders therefor. In counties having a population of less than 50,000, the board may delegate its power in regard to current accounts, claims, demands or causes of action against the county to a standing committee where the amount does not exceed  $\frac{$2,500 \text{ and in all }$5,000$ . In counties

having a population of 50,000 or more, the board may delegate its power in regard to current accounts, claims, demands or causes of action against the county to a standing committee where if the amount does not exceed \$5,000 \$10,000. Instead of delegating its power under this paragraph to a standing committee, the board may, by resolution adopted by majority vote, delegate such power to the chairperson of a standing committee. Such a resolution remains in effect for one year after its effective date or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
