AN ACT to create 125.10 (4) of the statutes, relating to presence of persons on premises licensed for the retail sale of alcohol beverages at certain times.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 125.10 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

125.10 (4) REGULATION OF CLOSED RETAIL PREMISES. A municipality may not prohibit the licensee, employes, salespersons or service personnel from being present on premises operated under a Class "A", Class "B", "Class A" or "Class B" license during hours when the premises are not open for business if those persons are performing job-related activities.
