1987 Wisconsin Act 176

AN ACT to amend 119.08 (1) (c) of the statutes, relating to eligibility for membership on the Milwaukee school board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 119.08 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

119.08 (1) (c) A person elected to represent a district shall reside within the boundaries of the district, except that if a person ceases to reside within the district because the boundaries of the district are changed during the person's term of office, the person may continue to serve for the balance of the term for which

he or she was elected for so long as the person resides in the school district. No person is eligible to be a member of the board if that person holds an office in any political organization or a lucrative city, county or state office, other than the office of notary public. Before taking office, the members of the board shall take the official oath of office and file it, duly certified by the officer administering the oath, with the city clerk.
