1987 Wisconsin Act 206

AN ACT to amend 118.125 (2) (intro.); and to create 118.125 (2) (k) of the statutes, relating to disclosing a dependent adult pupil's records to the pupil's parents or guardian.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.125 (2) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

118.125 (2) CONFIDENTIALITY. (intro.) All pupil records maintained by a public school shall be confidential, except as provided in pars. (a) to (j) (k). The school board shall adopt regulations to maintain the confidentiality of such records.

SECTION 2. 118.125 (2) (k) of the statutes is created to read:

118.125 (2) (k) A school board may disclose personally identifiable information from the pupil records of an adult pupil to the parents or guardian of the adult pupil, without the written consent of the adult pupil, if the adult pupil is a dependent of his or her parents or guardian under 26 USC 152, unless the adult pupil has informed the school, in writing, that the information may not be disclosed.
