1987 Wisconsin Act 280

AN ACT to amend 29.598 (7) (b) 3; and to create 29.598 (7) (bm) of the statutes, relating to wildlife damage claim payments.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.598 (7) (b) 3 of the statutes is amended to read:

29.598 (7) (b) 3. No person may receive any payment for the first $\frac{5500}{250}$ of each claim for wildlife damage.

SECTION 1m. 29.598 (7) (bm) of the statutes is created to read:

29.598 (7) (bm) If the land where the wildlife damage occurred is located in more than one participating county and the person files a statement of claim with more than one participating county, then the monetary restriction under par. (b) 3 shall be prorated between or among the participating counties based on the amount of wildlife damage occurring in each county.
