## 1987 Wisconsin Act 296

AN ACT to create 144.7965 of the statutes, relating to the disposal of yard waste.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 144.7965 of the statutes is created to read:

144.7965 Yard waste. (1) DEFINITION. In this section, "yard waste" means leaves, grass clippings, garden debris and brush, including clean woody

vegetative material no greater than 6 inches in diameter. This term does not include stumps, roots or shrubs with intact root balls.

(2) PROHIBITION. No person may dispose of yard waste in a solid waste disposal facility in this state.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect on January 1, 1993.
