1987 Wisconsin Act 324

AN ACT to create 62.22 (1e) of the statutes, relating to authorizing certain cities to accept gifts of land outside the city boundaries for industrial sites.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 62.22 (1e) of the statutes is created to read:

62.22 (1e) CERTAIN INDUSTRIAL SITES. The governing body of a 2nd class city which is adjacent to Lake Michigan and which is located in a county with a

population of less than 110,000, according to the most recent estimate by the department of administration, may acquire real property by gift outside the city boundaries for industrial sites; may improve and beautify the same; may construct, own, lease and maintain buildings on such property for public purposes; and may sell and convey such property.
