1987 Wisconsin Act 36

AN ACT to amend 118.15 (3) (b) of the statutes, relating to school board waiver of compulsory attendance.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.15 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

118.15 (3) (b) Any child excused for good cause by the school board of the district in which the child resides, in accordance with the school board's written attendance policy under s. 118.16 (4) and with the written approval of the child's parent or guardian; except that good cause may not be based upon the. <u>The child's truancy, discipline or school achievement</u> <u>problems or</u> exceptional educational needs as described in s. 115.76 (3) <u>may not be used as the rea-</u> <u>son for an excuse under this paragraph</u>. An <u>The</u> excuse <u>under this paragraph</u> shall be in writing and shall state the time period for which it is effective, not to exceed one extend beyond the end of the current <u>school</u> year.
