1987 Wisconsin Act 373

AN ACT relating to the administration of an in-place pollutant and river clean-up program and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions; natural resources. (1) IN-PLACE POLLUTANT AND RIVER CLEANUP. (a) The department of natural resources shall expend \$70,000 from the appropriation under section 20.370 (2) (ma) of the statutes in fiscal year 1987-88 to fund 2.0 FTE GPR positions authorized under 1987 Wisconsin Act 27 for the in-place pollutant and river clean-up program to be used for inplace pollutant and clean-up activities for the Milwaukee, Sheboygan and Menominee rivers and the Duluth harbor.

(b) The department of natural resources shall expend \$52,800 from the appropriation under section 20.370 (2) (ma) of the statutes for fiscal year 1987-88

for sediment and water quality sampling and modeling on the Fox river and Green bay.

SECTION 2. Appropriation changes; natural resources. (1) GENERAL PROGRAM OPERATIONS — STATE FUNDS. The appropriation to the department of natural resources under section 20.370 (2) (ma) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1987, is increased by \$240,000 for fiscal year 1987-88 and by \$240,000 for fiscal year 1988-89 to provide funding for 2.0 GPR project positions commencing on the effective date of this subsection and ending on June 30, 1989, to conduct sediment and water quality sampling and modeling on the Fox river and on Green bay, and for sediment and water quality sampling and modeling on the Fox river and on Green bay.
