1987 Wisconsin Act 402

AN ACT to create 20.435 (4) (ds) of the statutes, relating to establishing an emergency food assistance program and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

SECTION 2. 20.435 (4) (ds) of the statutes is created to read:

20.435 (4) (ds) Emergency food assistance. The amounts in the schedule to provide emergency food assistance under 1987 Wisconsin Act (this act), section 3. No moneys may be encumbered under this paragraph after October 31, 1988.

SECTION 3. Nonstatutory provisions; emergency food assistance. (1) The department of health and social services shall contract with Wisconsin producers, approved by the United States department of agriculture for the production of surplus food commodities, to purchase, transport and warehouse cheese and nonfat dry milk for distribution through October 1988, except that if the federal government resumes distribution of cheese and nonfat dry milk for

the federal fiscal year 1988 program before November 1988, the department of health and social services shall cease purchasing those commodities under this subsection. The department of health and social services shall fund the purchase and the cost of transporting and warehousing the cheese and nonfat dry milk from the appropriation under section 20.435 (4) (ds) of the statutes, as created by this act. The department of health and social services shall distribute the cheese and nonfat dry milk using the distribution system for the federal temporary emergency food assistance program, under P.L. 98-8 and P.L. 100-77.

(2) The department of health and social services shall enter into the contracts required under subsection (1) before July 1, 1988.
