1987 Wisconsin Act 46

AN ACT to renumber and amend 115.01 (5); and to create 115.01 (5) (a) (intro.) and (b) of the statutes, relating to school district names.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 115.01 (5) of the statutes is renumbered 115.01 (5) (a) 1 and amended to read:

115.01 (5) (a) 1. Each school district shall be known by the designation "School District of" followed by the name of the municipalities in which any high schools operated by the district lie, except that a school board may by resolution designate a different name for the school district; however, such name shall contain the words "School District".

2. A school district which does not operate a high school shall be known by number and by the name of the municipalities in which it lies.

SECTION 2. 115.01 (5) (a) (intro.) and (b) of the statutes are created to read:

115.01 (5) (a) (intro.) Except as provided under par. (b):

(b) A school board may by resolution designate a different name for the school district if the revised name contains the words "school district".
