1987 Wisconsin Act 49

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 29.47 (2) (c); and to create 29.47 (3) (c) of the statutes, relating to the transportation of fish subject to a minimum size limit which are taken by hook and line.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.47 (2) (c) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

29.47 (2) (c) All fish which are subject to a minimum size limit and are taken by hook and line may be transported with the head or tail, or both, removed and may be filleted before being transported, but only if the dressed or filleted fish continues to meet the minimum size limit. The dressed or filleted fish shall remain in one piece with the skin and scales intact.

SECTION 2. 29.47 (3) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

29.47 (3) (c) All fish which are subject to a minimum size limit and are taken by hook and line may be transported with the head or tail, or both, removed and may be filleted before being transported, but only if the dressed or filleted fish continues to meet the minimum size limit. The dressed or filleted fish shall remain in one piece with the skin and scales intact.
