1987 Wisconsin Act 87

AN ACT to repeal 70.06 (2) (a), (b) and (e), (3) and (4); and to amend 70.06 (2) (c) of the statutes, relating to the office of tax commissioner in 1st class cities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 70.06(2)(a), (b) and (e), (3) and (4) of the statutes are repealed.

SECTION 2. 70.06 (2) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

70.06 (2) (c) The tax commissioner may, with the approval of the common council, appoint one chief assessor, one or more chief appraisers, one or more supervising assessors and supervising appraisers, one or more property appraisers and other expert technical personnel that the tax commissioner deems necessary in order that all valuations throughout the city

are uniformly made in accordance with law. The chief assessor, chief appraiser and, supervising assessors and assistant supervising assessors shall exercise the direction and supervision over assessment procedure and shall perform the duties in relation to the assessment of property that the tax commissioner determines. Together with the property appraiser (land) and the deputy tax commissioner and the supervisor of administration and records, they shall be members of the board of assessors and shall hold office in the same manner as assessors. Certification of the assessment roll shall be limited to the members of the board of assessors.
