1989 WISCONSIN ACT 149

AN ACT to direct expenditure of \$34,648.97 from the general fund for payment of a claim against the state made by Andrew Bath.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.505 (4) (d) of the statutes \$34,648.97 in payment of a claim against the state made by Andrew Bath,

Fox Lake, Wisconsin, to reimburse him for attorney fees incurred in the defense of a charge filed under section 940.29 (1) of the statutes, of which he was found not guilty. Acceptance of this payment releases this state and its officers, employes and agents from any further claim resulting from the incident which gave rise to the filing of this charge.
