1989 WISCONSIN ACT 169

AN ACT *to amend* 15.05 (3) and 230.08 (2) (fs); and *to create* 38.04 (2m) of the statutes, **relating to:** authorizing the director of the vocational, technical and adult education system to appoint an executive assistant and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.05 (3) of the statutes, as affected by 1989 Wisconsin Act 31, is amended to read:

15.05 (3) EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT. Each secretary may appoint an executive assistant to serve at his or her pleasure outside the classified service. The executive assistant shall perform duties as the secretary prescribes. In this subsection, "secretary" includes the attorney general, the adjutant general, the director of the vocational, technical and adult education system and the state superintendent of public instruction.

SECTION 2. 38.04 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

38.04 (2m) EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT. The director may appoint an executive assistant, outside the classified service, to serve at his or her pleasure.

SECTION 3. 230.08 (2) (fs) of the statutes, as affected by 1989 Wisconsin Act 31, is amended to read:

230.08 (2) (fs) All deputies of department secretaries appointed under s. 15.04 (2) and executive assistants to department secretaries appointed under s. 15.05 (3), including those appointed by the attorney general, the adjutant general, the director of the vocational, technical and adult education system and the state superintendent of public instruction.

SECTION 4. Appropriation changes; vocational, technical and adult education. The dollar amounts in the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the board of vocational, technical and adult education under section 20.292 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1989, are increased by \$51,500 for fiscal year 1989–90 and by \$77,300 for fiscal year 1990–91 to increase the authorized FTE positions for the board of vocational, technical and adult education by 1.0 GPR position.
