1989 WISCONSIN ACT 184

AN ACT to amend 39.47 (2) of the statutes, relating to: the Minnesota–Wisconsin student reciprocity agreement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 39.47 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

39.47 (2) The agreement under this section shall provide for the waiver of nonresident tuition for a resident of either state who is enrolled in a public vocational school located in the other state. The agreement shall also establish a reciprocal fee structure for residents of either state who are enrolled in public institutions of higher education, other than vocational schools, located in the other

state. The reciprocal fee shall be the average academic fee that would be charged the student at a comparable public institution of higher education located in his or her state of residence, as specified in the agreement. The agreement shall take effect on July 1, 1983, and extend through the academic year ending June 30, 1991. The agreement shall provide for a biennial review of the costs, charges and payments associated with the agreement. The agreement is subject to the approval of the joint committee on finance under s. 39.42.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect on July 1, 1991.
