1989 WISCONSIN ACT 204

AN ACT relating to requiring the department of public instruction to study educational programming in secured correctional facilities and child caring institutions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions; public instruction. (1) The department of public instruction shall conduct a study of the educational programming in all of the secured correctional facilities, as defined in section 48.02 (15m) of the statutes, in this state and all child caring institutions licensed in this state to determine whether minimum educational requirements can be

imposed on such programming and, if so, what those requirements should be. The department of public instruction shall submit its findings and recommendations for minimum requirements, if any, to the chief clerk of each house of the legislature for distribution to the appropriate standing committees on education and juvenile justice, in the manner provided in section 13.172 (3) of the statutes, by January 1, 1991, or the first day of the 12th month beginning after publication, whichever occurs later.
