1989 WISCONSIN ACT 208

AN ACT to renumber 20.923 (4) (d) 8; and to amend 20.923 (6) (bg) and 230.08 (2) (c) and (e) 5m of the statutes, relating to: division administrator positions for the state historical society and executive salary group reassignment of the historical society director position.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.923 (4) (d) 8. of the statutes is renumbered 20.923 (4) (g) 1r.

SECTION 2. 20.923 (6) (bg) of the statutes, as created by 1989 Wisconsin Act 31, is amended to read:

20.923 (6) (bg) Historical society: assistant directors, librarian of the historical society library, state archivist and state historian.

SECTION 3. 230.08 (2) (c) and (e) 5m of the statutes are amended to read:

230.08 (2) (c) The director, associate director, assistant directors, librarian of the historical society library, state archivist and state historian of the historical society; and, with the approval of the board of curators and the administrator, such number of specialists as are required by the society for specific research, writing, collecting or editing projects which for a limited period of time not to exceed 2 years, renewable at the discretion of the board

of curators and the administrator for an additional 2–year period, require persons with particular training or experience in a specialized phase or field of history, historical research, writing, collecting or editing, and any persons whose entire salary is paid from funds reappropriated to the society by s. 20.245 (1) (g) where competitive examination is impractical.

(e) 5m. Historical society — 2 <u>6</u>.

SECTION 4. Nonstatutory provisions; historical society director salary. Notwithstanding section 20.923 (intro.) and (14) of the statutes or any provision of the compensation plan concerning executive salary groups as adopted by the joint committee on employment relations under section 230.12 (3) (b) of the statutes, the board of curators of the state historical society may, prior to July 1, 1990, set a salary for the position of director of the historical society. A salary established pursuant to this SECTION may not exceed 138.5% of the minimum dollar value of the salary range for executive salary group 7.
