## **1989 WISCONSIN ACT 214**

AN ACT *to amend* 29.57 (4); and *to create* 29.557 of the statutes, **relating to:** wild turkey hunting in state parks and granting rule–making authority.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.557 of the statutes is created to read: 29.557 Hunting on land in state parks and state fish hatcheries. (1) Except as provided in sub. (3), no person may hunt or trap on land located in state parks or state fish hatcheries.

(2) Except as provided in sub. (3), no person may have in his or her possession or under his or her control a firearm on land located in state parks or state fish hatcheries unless the firearm is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case.

(3) A person may hunt deer or wild turkeys in a state park or in a portion of a state park, designated by the department by rule, for that type of hunting if the person holds the approvals required under this chapter for that type of hunting.

**SECTION 2.** 29.57 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.57 (4) ABSOLUTE PROTECTION. Except as provided in s. 29.56 no owner of lands embraced within any such wildlife refuge, and no other person, shall may hunt or trap within the boundaries of any wildlife refuge, state park or state fish hatchery lands; nor <u>or</u> have in his <u>or her</u> possession or under his <u>or her</u> control therein any gun or rifle, unless the same is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case; but deer may be hunted in those state parks or portions thereof designated by the department. Nothing in this section shall may prohibit, prevent or interfere with the department, or its wardens, agents or employes, in the destruction of injurious animals.
