1989 WISCONSIN ACT 254

AN ACT *to amend* 20.445 (1) (dm), 101.142 (title) and (2), 101.143 (1) (fg) and 101.143 (4) (b) 15 of the statutes, relating to: discharges from aboveground petroleum product storage tanks and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.445 (1) (dm) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.445 (1) (dm) Storage tank inventory. The amounts in the schedule to conduct an inventory of <u>aboveground petroleum product storage tanks and</u> unused underground petroleum product storage tanks under s. 101.142.

SECTION 2. 101.142 (title) and (2) of the statutes are amended to read:

101.142 (title) **Inventory of petroleum product storage tanks.**

(2) (title) INVENTORY OF STORAGE TANKS. The department shall undertake a program to inventory and determine the location of <u>aboveground storage tanks and</u> unused underground storage tanks. The department may require its deputies and any person engaged in the business of distributing petroleum products to provide information on the location of <u>aboveground storage tanks and</u> unused underground storage tanks. The department shall develop uniform procedures for reporting the location of

<u>aboveground storage tanks and</u> unused underground storage tanks.

SECTION 3. 101.143 (1) (fg) of the statutes, as affected by 1989 Wisconsin Act 31, is amended to read: 101.143 (1) (fg) "Petroleum product storage system"

means an underground petroleum product a storage tank system that is located in this state and is used to store petroleum products together with any on–site integral piping or dispensing system. The term does not include pipeline facilities, tanks of 110 gallons or less capacity, farm and residential tanks of 1,100 gallons or less capacity storing petroleum products that are not for resale, tanks used for storing heating oil for consumptive use on the premises where stored or tanks owned by this state or the federal government.

SECTION 4m. 101.143 (4) (b) 15. of the statutes, as created by 1989 Wisconsin Act 31, is amended to read:

101.143 **(4)** (b) 15. For an owner or operator only, compensation to 3rd parties for bodily injury and property damage caused by a petroleum products discharge from a <u>an underground</u> petroleum <u>products product</u> storage <u>tank</u> system.
