1989 WISCONSIN ACT 296

AN ACT to renumber and amend 29.415 (4) (c); to amend 29.415 (4) (b); and to create 29.415 (4) (c) 1 and 29.415 (4) (c) 2 of the statutes, relating to: wild plants of endangered or threatened species.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 2. 29.415 (4) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.415 (4) (b) No person may process or sell to another person any a wild plant of an endangered or threatened species of wild plant.

SECTION 3. 29.415 (4) (c) of the statutes is renumbered 29.415 (4) (c) (intro.) and amended to read:

29.415 **(4)** (c) (intro.) No person may remove or transport do any of the following to any wild plant of an endangered or threatened species of wild plant away

from its native habitat that is on public property or on property which that he or she does not own or lease, except in the course of forestry or agricultural practices or in the construction, operation or maintenance of a utility facility:

SECTION 4. 29.415 (4) (c) 1. of the statutes is created to read:

29.415 (4) (c) 1. Remove, transport or carry away the wild plant from the place where it is growing.

SECTION 5. 29.415 (4) (c) 2. of the statutes is created to read:

29.415 (4) (c) 2. Cut, root up, sever, injure or destroy the wild plant.
