1989 WISCONSIN ACT 343

AN ACT *to create* 84.103 (1r) and 84.1035 of the statutes, **relating to:** designating and marking certain highway routes as the "Peace Memorial Highway" and the "World War II Veterans Memorial Highway".

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 84.103 (1r) of the statutes is created to read:

84.103 (1r) WORLD WAR II VETERANS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. The department shall designate and mark USH 41 commencing at Milwaukee and proceeding northerly to Marinette as the "World War II Veterans Memorial Highway" as a living memorial to and in honor of all Wisconsin veterans, living and dead, of World War II.

SECTION 4. 84.1035 of the statutes is created to read:

84.1035 Peace memorial highway. The department shall designate and mark USH 53 commencing at La Crosse and proceeding northerly to Superior as the "Peace Memorial Highway" to commemorate the contributions and devotion of the citizens of this state to international peace and greater understanding among nations. The department shall erect markers at regular intervals along the route, including at appropriate areas historical markers, to clearly identify to motorists the designation of the highway as a memorial to international peace.
