1989 WISCONSIN ACT 352

AN ACT to renumber and amend 30.275 (2); and to create 30.275 (2) (b) of the statutes, relating to: designating a portion of the Rock river a scenic urban waterway.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 30.275 (2) of the statutes is renumbered 30.275 (2) (intro.) and amended to read:

30.275 (2) DESIGNATION. (intro.) The <u>following</u> waters are designated scenic urban waterways and shall receive special management as provided under this section:

(a) The Illinois Fox river and its watershed and the

Fox river, extending from Lake Winnebago to Green Bay, and its watershed are designated scenic urban waterways and shall receive special management as provided under this section.

SECTION 2. 30.275 (2) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

30.275 (2) (b) The Rock river from the point it flows into the city of Janesville to the Illinois border.

SECTION 3. Effective date. The provisions of this act take effect on July 1, 1991.
