## 1989 WISCONSIN ACT 356

AN ACT *to repeal* 66.902 (5); and *to create* 66.902 (1) (a) 4 of the statutes, **relating to:** expanding the authority of a metropolitan sewerage district to prohibit or restrict the discharge of certain substances into its system.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 66.902 (1) (a) 4. of the statutes is created to read:

66.902 (1) (a) 4. Prohibit or restrict discharge into the sewerage system of the district's service area of any substance if the discharge of that substance would do any of the following:

- a. Interfere with the district's ability to meet its obligations under a pollution discharge elimination permit or general permit issued under s. 147.02 or 147.023, or under an air pollution control permit issued under subch. III of ch. 144.
- b. Interfere with the marketing of treated sewage sludge by the district.

**SECTION 2.** 66.902 (5) of the statutes is repealed.
