1989 WISCONSIN ACT 38

AN ACT *to amend* 343.10 (1) (b) of the statutes, **relating to:** the eligibility of a homemaker for an occupational license.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 343.10(1)(b) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.10 (1) (b) *Petition for occupational license*. If a person's license or operating privilege is revoked or suspended under this chapter and if the person is engaged

in an occupation, including <u>homemaking or</u> full—time or part—time study, or a trade making it essential that he or she operate a motor vehicle, the person, after complying with sub. (2), may file with a judge of a circuit court in the county of his or her residence or of a municipal court in the county of his or her residence a petition setting forth in detail the need for operating a motor vehicle.
