1989 WISCONSIN ACT 48

AN ACT to amend 59.15 (1) (a) 2 of the statutes, relating to: compensation for sheriffs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 59.15 (1) (a) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

59.15 (1) (a) 2. The board shall establish by resolution or ordinance the annual compensation of the sheriff as straight salary. No portion of that salary may include

or be based on retention of fees by the sheriff. <u>No portion</u> of that salary may be based on providing food to prisoners <u>under s. 53.37 (1)</u>. This subdivision does not prohibit the reimbursement of a sheriff for actual and necessary expenses.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability. This act first applies to terms of sheriffs commencing on the effective date of this SECTION.
