1991 WISCONSIN ACT 184

AN ACT *to create* 38.22 (6) (d) of the statutes, **relating to:** specifying that certain refugees are Wisconsin residents for entrance to and tuition at vocational, technical and adult education schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 38.22 (6) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

38.22 (6) (d) Any person who is a refugee, as defined under 8 USC 1101 (a) (42), who moved to this state immediately upon arrival in the United States and who has resided in this state continuously since then, if he or she demonstrates an intent to establish and maintain a permanent home in Wisconsin.
