1991 WISCONSIN ACT 196

AN ACT *to repeal* 118.153 (1) (am); and *to amend* 20.255 (2) (ec) of the statutes, **relating to:** alternative educational programs for learnfare pupils in the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.255 (2) (ec) of the statutes, as affected by 1991 Wisconsin Act 39, is amended to read:

20.255 (2) (ec) Aid to Milwaukee public schools. The amounts in the schedule to correct the academic deficiencies of educationally and economically disadvantaged pupils and to achieve a more effective and responsive educational program in the school district operating under ch. 119. In the 1991–92 fiscal year, the amount in the schedule shall be distributed as provided under ss. 119.71, 119.72, 119.74, 119.75, 119.78 and 119.82. In

the 1992–93 fiscal year, the amount in the schedule, other than the amount specified under s. 119.82 (3), shall be distributed according to the spending plan under s. 119.80. The department of public instruction may not distribute any funds in the appropriation under this paragraph in the 1992–93 fiscal year, other than the funds specified under s. 119.82 (3), until the spending plan for that fiscal year has been approved under s. 119.80.

SECTION 2. 118.153 (1) (am) of the statutes, as created by 1991 Wisconsin Act 39, is repealed.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect retroactively to August 15, 1991.
