1993 WISCONSIN ACT 178

AN ACT to amend 304.06 (1) (d) 3 of the statutes, relating to: discretionary parole notices.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 304.06 (1) (d) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

304.06(1)(d) 3. The notice shall state the name of the inmate, the crime of which he or she was convicted, the date and term of the sentence and the date when the writ-

ten statement must be received in order to be considered. If the notice is to an office under par. (c) 1. or 2., the notice shall also state the crime of which the inmate was convicted.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability; corrections. (1) PAROLE CONSIDERATION NOTICE. The treatment of section 304.06(1)(d) 3 of the statutes first applies to notices sent on the effective date of this subsection.
