1993 WISCONSIN ACT 222

AN ACT to amend 450.10 (1) (a) 2, 450.10 (1) (a) 5, 450.10 (1) (a) 6 and 450.10 (1) (b) 3 of the statutes, relating to: the disciplinary authority of the pharmacy examining board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 450.10 (1) (a) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

450.10 (1) (a) 2. Violating this chapter or ch. 161 or any federal or state statute or rule which substantially relates to the practice of pharmacy the licensee.

SECTION 2. 450.10 (1) (a) 5. of the statutes is amended to read:

450.10 (1) (a) 5. Making a substantial misrepresentation in the course of practice which is relied upon by a cli-

ent or patient another person.

SECTION 3. 450.10 (1) (a) 6. of the statutes is amended to read:

450.10 (1) (a) 6. Engaging in conduct in the practice of pharmacy the licensee which evidences a lack of knowledge or ability to apply professional principles or skills.

SECTION 4. 450.10 (1) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

450.10 (1) (b) 3. Been found guilty of an offense the circumstances of which substantially relate to the practice of pharmacy the licensee.
