1993 WISCONSIN ACT 300

AN ACT to amend 61.73 and 66.436 of the statutes, relating to: extending to villages the authority to create housing authorities for elderly persons.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 61.73 of the statutes is amended to read: 61.73 Village housing authorities. The provisions of ss. 66.40 66.395 to 66.425 shall apply to villages, and the powers and duties conferred and imposed by ss. 66.40 66.395 to 66.425 upon mayors, councils and specified city officials are hereby conferred upon presidents, village boards and village officials performing duties similar to the duties of such the specified city officials respectively. Any ordinance or resolution heretofore passed by any village board creating a housing authority in substantially the manner provided in ss. 66.40 to 66.404 is hereby declared to be valid, and any village housing authorities whether heretofore or hereafter created shall be entitled to <u>may</u> participate in any state grants-in-aid for housing in the same manner as city housing authorities created under ss. 66.40 <u>66.395</u> to 66.404.

SECTION 2. 66.436 of the statutes is amended to read: **66.436 Villages to have certain city powers.** Villages shall have all of the powers of cities under ss. 66.405 <u>66.395</u> to 66.425, 66.43, 66.431, 66.4325, 66.435 and 66.46.
