1993 WISCONSIN ACT 359

AN ACT to amend 345.20 (2) (c); and to create 972.11 (3m) of the statutes, relating to: evidence from another state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 345.20 (2) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

345.20 (2) (c) Section Sections 967.055 applies and 972.11 (3m) apply to traffic forfeiture actions for violations of s. 346.63 (1) or (5) or a local ordinance in conformity therewith.

SECTION 2. 972.11 (3m) of the statutes is created to

read:

972.11 (**3m**) A court may not exclude evidence in any criminal action or traffic forfeiture action for violation of s. 346.63 (1) or (5), or a local ordinance in conformity with s. 346.63 (1) or (5), on the ground that the evidence existed or was obtained outside of this state.

SECTION 3. Initial applicability. The treatment of sections 345.20 (2) (c) and 972.11 (3m) of the statutes first applies to actions commenced on the effective date of this Section.
