## **1993 WISCONSIN ACT 367**

AN ACT to amend 20.255 (2) (dt); and to create 118.30 (2) (b) 3 and 118.30 (2) (b) 4 of the statutes, relating to: excusing certain pupils from the mandatory, statewide examinations in the 8th and 10th grades and making an appropriation.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1g.** 20.255 (2) (dt) of the statutes, as created by 1993 Wisconsin Act 16, is amended to read:

20.255 (2) (dt) *Pupil assessment*. The amounts in the schedule to reimburse school districts for the costs of the examinations administered under s. 118.30 <u>and the notices provided under s. 118.30 (2) (b) 3.</u>

**SECTION 1m.** 118.30 (2) (b) 3. of the statutes is created to read:

118.30 (2) (b) 3. Annually, the school board shall notify the parent or guardian of each pupil enrolled in the

8th and 10th grades in the school district, including pupils enrolled in charter schools located in the school district, that he or she may request the school board to excuse the pupil from taking an examination administered under this section. Upon the request of a pupil's parent or guardian, the school board shall excuse the pupil from taking an examination administered under this section.

**SECTION 2.** 118.30 (2) (b) 4. of the statutes is created to read:

118.30 (2) (b) 4. The state superintendent may provide the notice to be used by school boards under subd. 3.
