1993 WISCONSIN ACT 376

AN ACT *to amend* 349.11 (10) of the statutes, **relating to:** temporary reduction of speed limits by local highway authorities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 349.11 (10) of the statutes is amended to read:

349.11 (10) Notwithstanding any speed limits imposed under this section or under s. 346.57, if a highway is being constructed, reconstructed, maintained or repaired, local authorities with respect to highways under their jurisdiction and, any county highway committee performing maintenance on the state trunk highway system under s. 84.07 and any local authority with respect to highways not under its jurisdiction that are being

constructed, reconstructed, maintained or repaired by the local authority may, for the safety of the highway construction and maintenance workers, pedestrians and highway users, post a temporary speed limit less than the speed limit imposed under this section or under s. 346.57. The temporary limits may be posted only during periods when actual for the duration of the construction, reconstruction, maintenance or repair is taking place period. Temporary speed limits imposed under this subsection may be posted with portable signs on portable supports. When portable supports are used under this subsection, the bottom of the sign shall be not less than one foot above the surface of the pavement or shoulder.
