1993 WISCONSIN ACT 424

AN ACT to amend 804.10 (1) and 804.12 (2) (a) 4 of the statutes, relating to: permitting a court to order a party in a civil action to submit to a vocational examination.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 804.10 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

804.10 (1) When the mental or physical condition (, including the blood group) or the ability to pursue a vocation, of a party is in issue, the court in which the action is pending may order the party to submit to a physical Θ , mental or vocational examination. The order may be made on motion for cause shown and upon notice to all parties and shall specify the time, place, manner, con-

ditions and scope of the examination and the person or persons by whom it is to be made.

SECTION 2. 804.12 (2) (a) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

804.12 (2) (a) 4. In lieu of any of the foregoing orders or in addition thereto, an order treating as a contempt of court the failure to obey any orders except an order to submit to a physical Θ_{r_a} mental <u>or vocational</u> examination.

SECTION 3. Initial applicability. This act first applies to civil actions pending on the effective date of this SECTION.
