## **1993 WISCONSIN ACT 47**

AN ACT to renumber 230.35 (1m) (a) 1 to 5; to amend 230.35 (1m) (a) (intro.); and to create 230.35 (1m) (a) 4 of the statutes, relating to: annual leave of absence for state–employed attorneys.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 230.35 (1m) (a) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

230.35 (**1m**) (a) (intro.) Employes appointed to <u>any</u> of the following positions shall be entitled to annual leave of absence at the rate provided under par. (bt):

1. A career executive positions position under the program established under s. 230.24 or positions.

<u>2. A position</u> designated in s. 19.42 (10) (L) or 20.923 (4), (4m), (8) and (9)  $\Theta \underline{r}_{\underline{i}}$ 

<u>3. A position authorized under s. 230.08 (2) (e).</u> (bt) An employe appointed to a position listed under <u>par. (a)</u> shall be entitled to annual leave of absence without loss of pay based upon accumulated continuous state service at the rate of:

**SECTION 2.** 230.35 (1m) (a) 1. to 5. of the statutes are renumbered 230.35 (1m) (bt) 1 to 5.

**SECTION 3.** 230.35 (1m) (a) 4. of the statutes is created to read:

230.35 (**1m**) (a) 4. A position designated as an attorney position in which the employe is employed and acts as an attorney, unless the attorney position is a limited term appointment under s. 230.26.

**SECTION 4.** Initial applicability. This act first applies to an employe who is employed by the state in an attorney position on January 1, 1994.
