1995 WISCONSIN ACT 172

AN ACT to amend 448.05 (5m) (a) 1. of the statutes; relating to: the requirements for persons applying for a certificate as an occupational therapist.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 448.05 (5m) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

448.05 (5m) (a) 1. Successfully completed the academic requirements and supervised internship of an edu-

ational program in occupational therapy recognized by the board and accredited by the ~~committee on allied health education and accreditation of the American medical association and accreditation council for occupational therapy education of~~ the American occupational therapy association.
