TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS FOR
HEALTH OFFICERS

H 106.01 Qualification requirements

H 106.01 Qualification requirements. To be eligible for appointment the applicant for health officer shall meet the training and experience requirements of subsections (1), (2) or (3):

(1) Successful completion of one academic year of training in an approved school of public health and one year experience in an administrative capacity.

(2) Successful completion of at least two quarters or one semester of academic training in an approved school of public health and two years of experience in the field of public health in a health department as defined under section 140.09 (1)(c), Wis. Stats., and one year in an administrative capacity.

(a) One or more additional years of experience in the field of public health may be substituted for one quarter of the academic training requirement.

(b) The requirements set forth under H 106.01 (2) as they apply to academic training may be waived by the local board of health provided that the applicant shows evidence that he is eligible for admission to an approved school of public health and provided that he agrees to attend such school and meet the training requirement within two years after his appointment.

(3) Five years of experience in the field of public health, all of which shall have been in an administrative capacity in a health department as defined under section 140.09 (1)(c), Wis. Stats.
