H 43.01 Definitions

H 43.01 Definitions. (1) FETAL DEATH. Fetal death is death prior to complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of conception after twenty weeks gestation and the death is indicated by the fact that after such separation, the fetus does not breathe or show any other evidence of life such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles.
