COMPENSATION PLAN

Pers 4.01 Definition

Pers 4.01 Definition. The compensation plan in effect as identified in the "Classification and Compensation Plan for Positions in the Classified Service" published by the bureau, composed of the various pay schedules, rates and ranges, within grade movements, and administrative directives and other provisions as approved pursuant to s. 16.086, Stats., together with amendments and revisions, shall constitute the official compensation plan for all positions in the classified service, subject to the provisions of s. 16.084, Stats. For the purpose of this definition the terms "pay schedule" and "salary schedule" are synonymous.

Note: Chapter 196, laws of 1977 vested responsibility for development of the compensation plan in the secretary, department of employment relations, rather than the administrator, division of personnel. The development of the plan affects the composition or definition of the compensation plan, which is the substance of the current rule. Despite the statutory change, Pers 4.01 shall remain in effect until repealed by the secretary.
