

thence east along the section line to the southeast corner of said section 5;

thence north along the section line to the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between sections 4 and 5;

thence east along the $\frac{1}{4}$ line to the center of section 4, T20N, R4W;

thence north along the $\frac{1}{4}$ line to the north section line of said section 4;

thence east along the section lines to the intersection with the southwest edge of existing U. S. Highway 12;

thence northwesterly along the southwest edge of said highway 12 to the intersection with the North-South $\frac{1}{4}$ line of section 23, township 21 North, range 4 West, being the place of beginning.

WCD 40.05 Apostle Islands State Forest. All state-owned lands now or that hereafter may come under the jurisdiction of the state conservation commission within the boundaries hereinafter described in Ashland county are hereby created, established and designated as the Apostle Islands State Forest.

(1) **STOCKTON ISLAND.** An island in Lake Superior situated in Ashland county, commonly known and referred to as Stockton Island, and located in Townships 51 and 52 North, Ranges 1 and 2 West.

(2) **OAK ISLAND.** An island in Lake Superior situated in Ashland county and commonly known and referred to as Oak Island and located in townships 51 and 52 North, Range 3 West.

(3) **BASSWOOD ISLAND.** An island in Lake Superior situated in Ashland county and commonly known and referred to as Basswood Island and located in Townships 50 and 51 North, Range 3 West.
