(b) Mud lake. Township 11 north, range 10 east, town of Lowville.




(9) Marquette county. (a) Germania. Township 17 north, range 10 east, town of Crystal Lake.




(d) Winona pool (Pool 5). Township 19 north, range 12 west, town of Buffalo.



(2) Crawford county. (a) Harpers slough (Pool 9). Township 9 north, range 6 west, town of Seneca.




(3) Grant county. (a) Dago slough (Pool 11). Township 2 north, range 4 west, town of Seneca.




