


A wildlife refuge is established in the following areas when posted with department signs and no person may hunt waterfowl at any time, or enter such areas for any reason from September 1 through December 31, except to hunt deer during the open season for hunting deer established in ss. NR 10.01 (3) (e) and 10.117.

(1) PEAT LAKE. Township 1 north, range 20 east, town of Salem.




(2) RACINE COUNTY. (a) Dover. Township 3 north, range 20 east, town of Dover.


